The Faculty of Computer Applications and Information Technology (PG) at GLS University organized an insightful expert session titled **“Surviving and Succeeding through the AI Revolution.”** The session was conducted on **10th March 2026** at the **GLS University Student Auditorium**, with the aim of helping students understand the transformative impact of Artificial Intelligence on industries, careers, and future technological innovations.

Artificial Intelligence has rapidly become one of the most influential technological advancements of the modern era. With organizations across the world integrating AI into their operations, there is an increasing demand for professionals who possess the knowledge and skills required to work alongside intelligent systems. Keeping this in mind, the seminar was organized to provide students with industry insights on how to adapt and thrive in an AI-driven ecosystem.

The session was delivered by **Jigar Joshi**, a distinguished industry expert with extensive experience in enterprise solutions, digital transformation, and technology leadership. Mr. Joshi shared his professional journey and explained how technological evolution, particularly AI, is reshaping business models and the global workforce.

During the seminar, Mr. Joshi highlighted the **growing significance of Artificial Intelligence across multiple sectors**, including energy, manufacturing, logistics, e-commerce, and finance. He explained how AI tools are being used to automate repetitive tasks, analyze large datasets, improve decision-making processes, and enhance productivity in organizations. Students were encouraged to view AI not as a threat to jobs, but as an opportunity to develop new capabilities and innovative solutions.

A key part of the presentation focused on **how students and young professionals can survive and succeed during the AI revolution**. Mr. Joshi emphasized the importance of continuous learning and staying

updated with emerging technologies. He explained that while AI can automate certain processes, it cannot replace human creativity, problem-solving abilities, and ethical decision-making. Therefore, students should focus on developing a combination of technical knowledge and soft skills.

Another important aspect discussed during the session was the **importance of adaptability and lifelong learning**. The speaker encouraged students to explore areas such as machine learning, data analytics, cloud computing, and AI-assisted tools. He also discussed how professionals should continuously upgrade their skills through online learning platforms, certifications, and hands-on projects.

The presentation also addressed the **ethical considerations associated with Artificial Intelligence**. Mr. Joshi explained that while AI offers significant benefits, it also raises concerns regarding data privacy, responsible use of technology, and transparency in automated decision-making systems. Students were encouraged to become responsible technologists who develop solutions that benefit society while maintaining ethical standards.

Throughout the session, students actively engaged with the speaker by asking questions related to career opportunities, AI-related skills, and industry expectations. The interaction allowed students to gain clarity on how they can prepare themselves for future roles in technology-driven organizations.

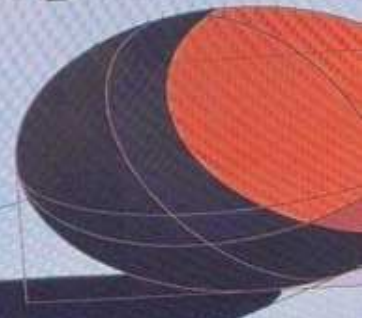
