

GUNI SciTech Fest 2025 (National Science Day)

The 28th February is celebrated as a National Science Day in India every year. It is being celebrated in honor of our Indian Scientist Sir C.V. Raman who invented Raman Effect. The discovery by C.V. Raman brought him the Nobel Prize in 1930, the first time for an Indian. Also, the Raman Effect was honored with the rank of being a National Historic Chemical Landmark by the American Chemical Society on 15 December 1998. He got designated as an International Historic Chemical Landmark in the year 2013 on the National Science Day. The entire nation celebrates the National Science Day as a science festival by organizing science exhibitions, workshops, seminars, symposiums, and many more activities. The aim to celebrate the day with great enthusiasm is to impart scientific temper in the minds of people of all age groups. Events are organized in educational institutes as well as research centers involving experts, learners, and scientists.

The Department of Science & Technology (DST) has been selecting themes for observing National Science Day every year. Accordingly, Ministry of Science & Technology conveyed that the theme selected for the National Science Day 2025 is **“Empowering Indian Youth for Global Leadership in Science & Innovation for Viksit Bharat”**.

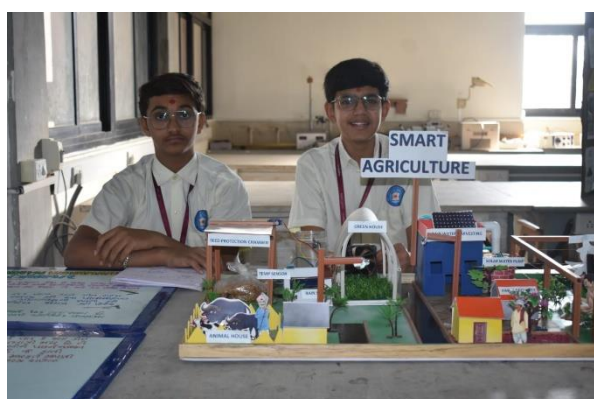

They learned new concepts and principles of various scientific terms and were able to design innovative solutions.

This year total 534 students have participated in different events.

Group/Individual Competitions:

(1) Working Model: This year total 52 groups had participated in working model. They were made on the basis of theme. Participated have presented model on Solar System, Bio-Diesel, Smoke absorber model, Oscillation counter, Sewage Treatment, Smart Plug, etc. They were evaluated by four judges nominated by the coordinators. Their names are Dr. P. U. Patel, Mr. Ankit Sinha, Dr. Bhavesh Thaka and Dr. Darshan Desai. The winners are selected for these reasons: complex and realistic model, solving problem of society, scope of commercialization, upgradation of current product etc. Here, are some glimpses of this event:



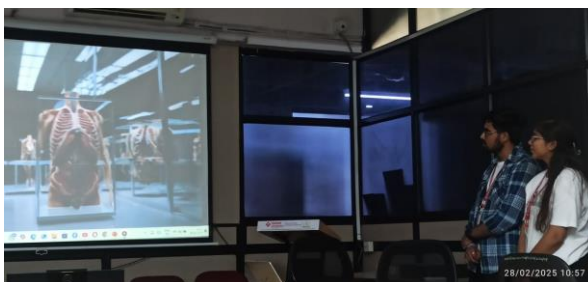
(2) Non-working Model: This year total 32 groups had participated in non-working model. All the models were based on the current theme. They have prepared model on Steam distillation model for extraction of essential oil, Stages of metastasis, Thermal batteries, Aaditay L1, Water Pollution Cleaning RC Boat etc. They were evaluated by two judges nominated by the coordinators. Their names are Dr. Pery Patel and Dr. Bharat Doshi. (3) Global Food Practices: This year total 27 groups had participated in Global Food Practices.
