Objective of the Event:

The primary objective of the event was to enhance participants' creativity, communication, and pitching skills by engaging them in a practical, interactive product-pitching activity. Through teamwork, strategic thinking, and real-time selling challenges, the event aimed to foster entrepreneurial mindset, improve persuasion abilities, and promote collaboration and active participation among students. Additionally, it sought to create an enjoyable learning environment that encouraged confidence-building and experiential learning.

On 22nd September 2025, the Entrepreneurship Club (E-cell) of the Institute of Advanced Research successfully organized the One Minute Game in A1- 317. The session was under the guidance of our Faculty Mentor cum SSIP Coordinator Dr. Anjali Mishra. The event was planned and executed by the E-cell Core Committee, President- Ms. Nirva Mehta, Vice President- Ms. Kavya Thakor, Secretary- Ms. Kashish Jain, along with the dedicated efforts of the volunteers of the club.

Brief Overview of the Event:

The event commenced with a warm welcome extended to all participants by our Vice President, **Ms. Kaavya Thakor**. Following this, the **core team members** were introduced, and the rules and regulations of the activity were explained to the participants.

The event featured a game designed to encourage creativity, communication, and pitching skills. Participants were divided into **4–5 groups**. Each group first submitted their product ideas, which were then shuffled and redistributed through a chit-picking process. Every team had to pitch the product mentioned in their chit to the **audience of students and faculty members** across the campus.

The scoring criteria were as follows:

- **10 points** for convincing a student to agree to purchase the product within one minute.
- **15 points** for convincing a faculty member.

To ensure smooth execution, each team was assigned **two volunteers** for score tallying, photography, and videography. Teams were given **20 minutes** to pitch their products within the campus. The team with the highest cumulative points was declared the winner.

The activity witnessed **enthusiastic participation** from all teams, creating an engaging and lively atmosphere. After the pitching round, everyone reassembled at the venue, where the results were declared. The **winners and two runners-up teams** were announced by **Mr. Milan Trivedi** and **Dr. Anjali Mishra**.

The event concluded on a successful note with active involvement, creative energy, and an enjoyable learning experience for all participants.

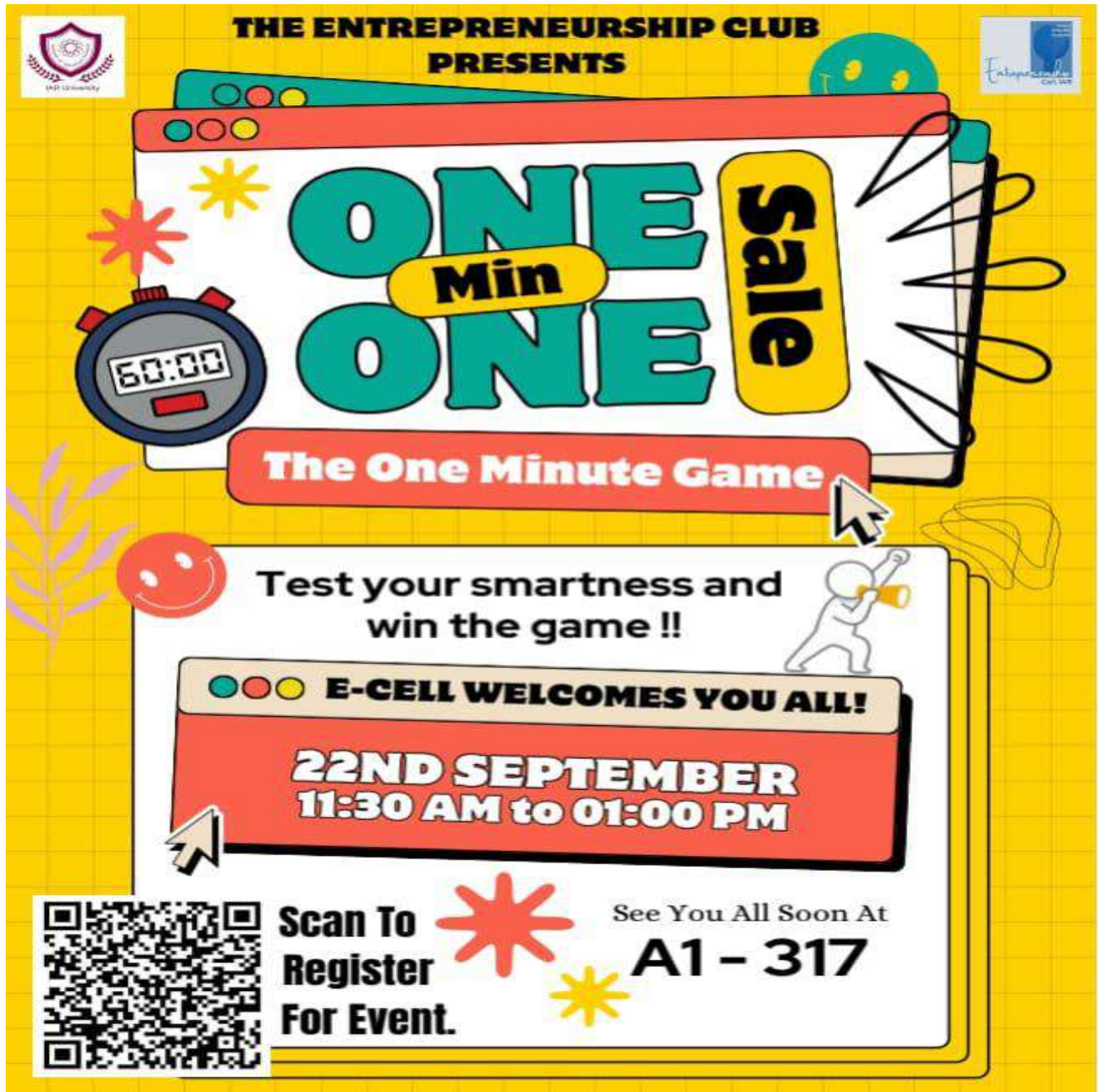
Outcome of the Event:
