Since 2003 SEMCOM has organized Best Business Idea Contest in order to foster creative & innovative thinking for business. From 2022 under the able leadership of CVM University; CVMU Innovation and Startup Cell in its ambit scaled up this competition from college level to university level. At Present, SSIP, Government of Gujarat sponsors, CVM University Innovation and Startup Cell (CVMUISC) to organises the competition which is being managed and hosted by SEMCOM and CZPatel College of Business Management at University Level.

This year, The Best Business Idea Competition (BBIC) witnessed enthusiastic participation from various colleges, with a total of 29 teams registering for the event. The competition aimed to encourage innovation, creativity, and entrepreneurial thinking among students.

After an initial screening and evaluation process, 13 teams were shortlisted for the final round based on the originality, feasibility, and potential impact of their business ideas.

To further support and prepare the shortlisted participants, expert-led workshops were organized on Idea Generation and Financial Planning by Mr. Sheel Dholakia and CA Kushal Dalal. These sessions provided valuable insights into refining business concepts, understanding market feasibility, and developing sound financial strategies. The workshops helped the participants strengthen their ideas and present them more effectively in the final round of the competition.

The final event is organized on 17th March, Tuesday 2026 at BVM Auditorium 10:00 a.m. onwards. The chief guest of the event was Mr. Anuj Pandey from XBD Consulting, Noida, Delhi and the event was presided by Er. Shri Bhikhubhai B. Patel, President, The Charutar Vidya Mandal (CVM) University.
