The SSIP 2.0 Awareness Programme was conducted with the following objectives:

- To educate students about the Student Startup and Innovation Policy (SSIP 2.0) and its benefits.
- To encourage students to develop innovative ideas and transform them into viable startups.
- To inform students about the financial support, grants, and mentorship opportunities available under SSIP 2.0.
- To guide students on the application process for submitting proposals for Proof of Concepts (PoCs), Prototypes, and IP support.
- To showcase success stories and ongoing SSIP activities at the institute to inspire participation.

Key Highlights of the Session

1. Overview of SSIP 2.0

- SSIP 2.0 is an initiative by the **Government of Gujarat** to foster innovation and entrepreneurship among students.
- It builds on the success of **SSIP 1.0**, focusing on creating a robust ecosystem for startups, intellectual property (IP) development, and commercialization of ideas.
- Implemented by the **Education Department, Government of Gujarat**, in collaboration with academic and industry partners.

2. Vision and Mission

- **Vision:** Empower Gujarat's youth to unlock their creative potential, contributing to *Aatmanirbhar Gujarat* and sustainable development.
- **Mission:**
 - Establish an end-to-end innovation and incubation ecosystem.

- Promote IP awareness, filing, and commercialization.
- Support **10,000+ student-led innovations, 5,000+ IP filings, and 1,500+ startups.**
- Strengthen mentorship, funding, and market access for startups.

3. Role of Stakeholders

- **Government:** Mandate, support, and scale initiatives.
- **Academic Stakeholders:** Deploy SSIP agenda and create support systems.
- **Industry & Ecosystem Partners:** Provide mentoring, market access, and domain expertise.

4. Financial Support & Grants

- **Proof of Concepts (PoCs) & Prototypes:**
 - School Students (Class 9-12): Up to ₹20,000 per innovation.
 - Higher Education Students: Up to ₹2.5 Lakhs per innovation.
- **IP Support:**
 - Patents (Domestic): Up to ₹75,000.
 - Patents (International): Up to ₹1.5 Lakhs.
 - Copyrights, Trademarks, Industrial Designs, etc., also covered.

5. Startup Definition & SSIP Fund Support

- A **startup** is defined as an entity with a scalable and replicable business model based on innovation.
- **Prototyping Support:** Up to ₹20 lakh annually per institute for 10-25 PoCs/MVPs.
- **Patent Support:** Up to ₹2.5 lakh for national and international patents.

6. Flagship Programs

- **Startup Srujan Seed Support (S4):** Grants of ₹2.5 Lakhs to ₹10 Lakhs for scalable startups.
- **Startup Sathi:** Mentorship program with industry experts.
- **WEstart:** Dedicated support for women-led startups.

- **Hackathons & Bootcamps:** Encouraging problem-solving through competitions.

7. How to Apply?

Students and innovators can follow these steps to avail of the support:

1. Register on the **SSIP Gujarat Portal** (<https://www.ssipgujarat.in/>).
2. Submit proposals for PoCs, Prototypes, or IP Support.
3. Get the proposal evaluated by the **Institutional Scrutiny Committee**.
4. Submit required documents, including the SSIP Fund Proposal Form and Bonafide Certificate.
