The GUNIprenuer Bootcamp was successfully organized with the objective of nurturing critical thinking, problem-solving abilities, and an entrepreneurial mindset among students. Through a series of intensive, hands-on workshops, the bootcamp provided participants with a comprehensive understanding of the innovation process, idea validation, and strategic thinking. Furthermore, participants developed stronger communication, persuasion, and teamwork abilities, and exhibited increased readiness to transition their ideas from conceptualization to execution.

They were exposed to real-world startup processes and entrepreneurial thinking, gaining valuable hands-on experience in project development and validation. The program also helped students build adaptability, storytelling, and branding skills—critical competencies for future innovators. Moreover, the event facilitated meaningful interactions with mentors and industry practitioners, expanding students' professional networks.

The program attracted over 100 participants from a diverse range of institutes and academic disciplines. It provided an enriching platform for experiential learning, meaningful interaction, and

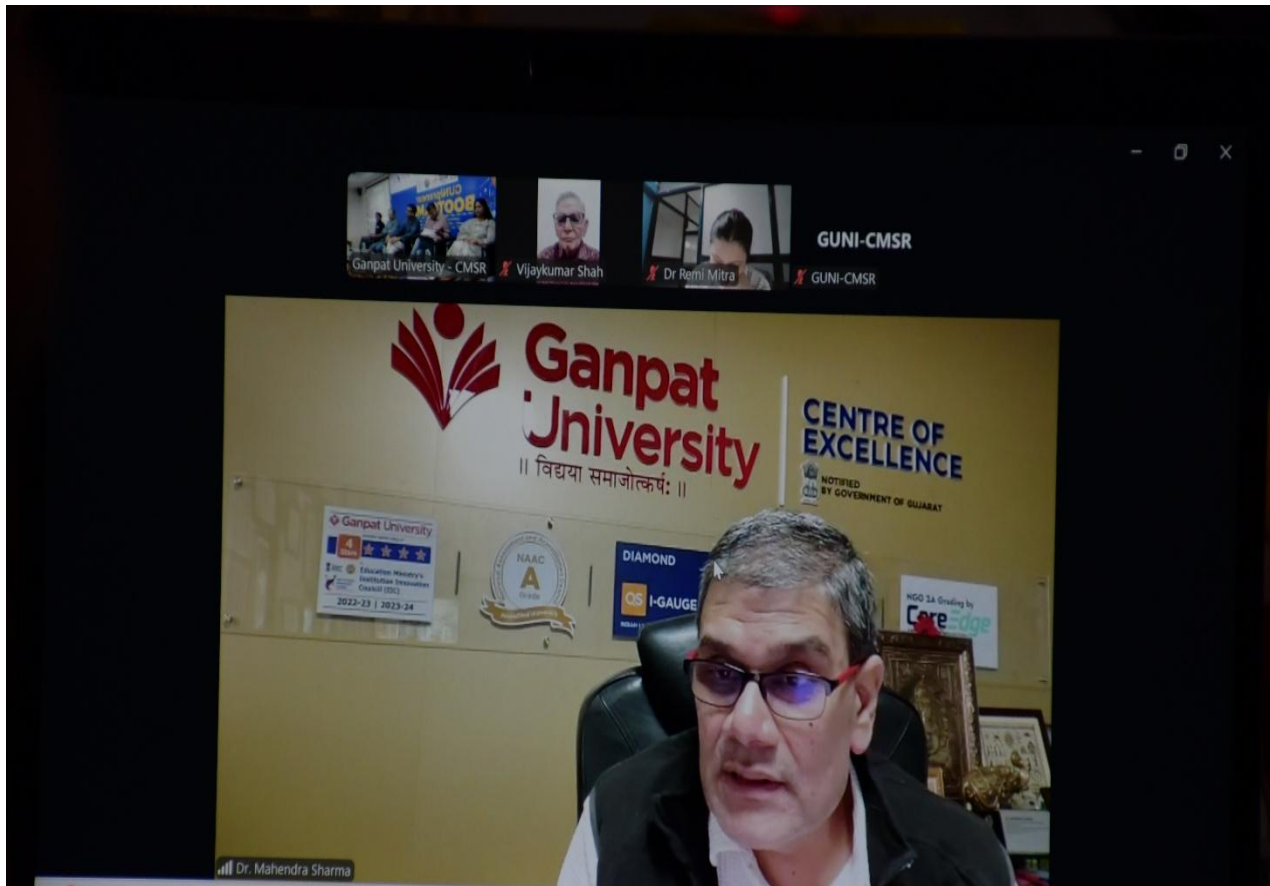
knowledge exchange with eminent resource persons, fostering a collaborative and inspiring environment for aspiring entrepreneurs.

A total of five teams were recognized for their outstanding performances across multiple categories like best startup idea, best presentation award, best innovation award, best market potential idea and special jury award. The program concluded with

a Valedictory Ceremony and Certificate Distribution, celebrating the achievements of all participants and marking the successful completion of the bootcamp.
