Report on SSIP 2.0 Grant Disbursement Ceremony

Introduction

The **SSIP 2.0 Grant Disbursement Ceremony** was organised by the SSIP Cell of **Government Commerce College, Naroda**, on **11 September 2026** to formally recognise and support student entrepreneurs whose innovative startup ideas had been approved for financial assistance under SSIP 2.0.

The ceremony provided a platform to acknowledge the entrepreneurial efforts of the students and encourage them to transform their innovative ideas into sustainable ventures. A total of **14 Proof of Concept (POC) projects** were approved, with a **total grant of ₹21,00,000**, of which **₹11,50,000 was approved for disbursement as the first instalment**.

Objectives of the Programme

The major objectives of the ceremony were:

- To formally disburse the first instalment of SSIP 2.0 grants to approved POC projects.
- To encourage students to pursue entrepreneurship and innovation.
- To provide financial support for the development and validation of innovative ideas.
- To motivate young innovators to move from the idea stage towards enterprise development.
- To create awareness about the opportunities available under SSIP 2.0.

The programme also motivated other students to explore entrepreneurship, identify problems around them and develop innovative solutions.
