Introduction:

The Mentoring Demo Day & Poster Presentation was organized to provide an interactive platform for student innovators, researchers, and early-stage startup founders to present their working prototypes and business models. The primary goal was to bridge the gap between academic projects and industry expectations by connecting student teams directly with domain experts and startup mentors.

Event overview:

The two-day exhibition kicked off with 18 student startup teams displaying physical prototypes, software demonstrations, and poster presentations. Industry mentors, venture evaluators, and senior faculty evaluated the projects across parameters such as technical novelty, design feasibility, and commercial scalability. One-on-one feedback sessions were conducted where mentors guided teams on refine-testing, customer acquisition, and regulatory compliance.

Outcome/Highlight:

- Startup Projects Showcase: Teams successfully exhibited prototypes across healthcare, edtech, green energy, and automation.
- Direct Mentor Linkages: 10 teams secured ongoing 1-on-1 mentorship commitments from industry experts.
- Refined Value Propositions: Innovators received critical feedback regarding field usability, safety, and customer pain points.
